### DESCRIPTION & DURATION OF YUGAS

The time is divided into 4 Yugas as follows:

(1) Satya Yuga (also called Krita Yuga):

Duration: 1,728,000 (1 Million 728 Thousand) Human Years.

Qualities & Characteristics: Known As The Golden Age or The Age of Truth. Supreme Virtue reigns everywhere.

Human Stature: 21 cubits (~30 ft height).

Lifespan: 100,000 (1 Hundred Thousand) years, and death occurs only when desired.

### (2) Treta Yuga:

Duration: 1,296,000 (1 Million 296 Thousand) Human Years.

Qualities & Characteristics: Known As the Silver Age.

Three quarters (75%) virtue and one quarter (25%) sin.

Human Stature: 14 cubits (~20 ft height).

Lifespan: 10,000 (Ten Thousand) years.

### (3) Dvapara Yuga:

**Duration:** 864,000 Human Years.

Qualities & Characteristics: Known as the Bronze Age.

One half (50%) virtue and one half (50%) sin.

Human Stature: 10 cubits (~14 ft height).

Lifespan: 1,000 years.

(4) Kali Yuga:

**Duration:** 432,000 Human Years.

Qualities & Characteristics: Known as the Iron Age. One quarter (25%) virtue and three quarters (75%) sin.

Human Stature: 3.5 cubits (~5 ft ht).

Lifespan: 100-120 yrs.

### DEFINITIONS OF MAHAYUGA & KALPA

### 1 Maha Yuga = Sum Total of 4 Yugas =

1,728,000 + 1,296,000 + 864,000 + 432,000 = 4,320,000 =

4.32 Million Human Years

### 1 Kalpa = 1000 Maha Yugas =

4.32 Million x 1000 =

4.32 Billion Human Years

### BRAHMA'S DAY & BRAHMA'S YEAR

Half a Day of Brahma (Day Time Only) = 1 Kalpa = 4.32 Billion Human Years

1 Full Day of Brahma (including Day + Night) =

2 Kalpas = 2 x 4.32 Billion Human Years =

8.64 Billion Human Years

1 Brahma Year =

8.64 Billion x 360 Days = 3,110,400,000

(3 Trillion 110 Billion 400 Million Human Years)

### OUR RELATIVE POSITION IN TIME

- We are in the 51st Brahma Year of 100 Brahma Years.
- We are in the 1st Brahma Day of the 51st Brahma Year, which is called the Varaha Kalpa.
  - We are in the 7<sup>th</sup> Manvantara of 1<sup>st</sup> Brahma Day
  - We are in the **28<sup>th</sup> Maha Yuga** of 7<sup>th</sup> Manvantara.

# OUR RELATIVE POSITION IN TIME (Contd.)

- We are in the 454<sup>th</sup> Maha Yuga of the 1,000 Maha Yugas that comprise half a day of Brahma
  - We are in Kali Yuga of the 454th Maha Yuga
  - We are in the 5117<sup>th</sup> Year of Kali Yuga
    This means that we are fairly early in Kali Yuga, and
  - <u>426,883 Years More to Go before the end of Kaliyuga</u> of the 454<sup>th</sup> Maha Yuga of Brahma's 1<sup>st</sup> day in his 51<sup>st</sup> year

# CONTRAST BETWEEN VEDIC & SCIENTIFIC CONCEPTS ABOUT TIME & CREATION OF UNIVERSE

### **Vedic Concept:** Time is Cyclical in Nature

which means all things that exist (except the Brahman), are repeated and recycled forever.

### Scientific Concept: Time is Linear in Nature

# CONSISTENCY BETWEEN VEDIC & SCIENTIFIC PREDICTIONS ABOUT WHEN THE LIFE ON EARTH WILL END

### **Vedic Assumptions & Predictions**:

- (1) Brahma Goes to Sleep After Completing Each Half a Day = 1 Kalpa = 1000 Maha Yugas = 4.32 Billion Human Years

    - (3) Each Maha Yuga = 4.32 Million Human Years
  - (4) Number of Years To Be Completed in the 1st Day of

Brahma's Yr 51 =  $4.32 \times (1000 - 454) - 0.427 = 2.36$  Billion Human Yrs

Therefore, <u>after 2.36 Billion Years</u>, which will complete 1 Kalpa, there will be no life on earth since Brahma will go to sleep.
