The seven great Sages, the four great Saints before them, and the fourteen Manus, are all born from my mind. From them, all the people in the world have descended.





DEFINITION OF A MANVANTARA

- 1 Brahma's Day (or 1 Kalpa) is Ruled by 14/Manus.
- ☐ The Duration of Time Ruled by Each Manu is Called a Manvantara.
- □ Therefore, Each Manvantara = 1/14th of 1 Kalpa
 - = 1/14th of 1000 Maha Yugas
 - = 71.43 Maha Yugas
 - = 308.57 Million Years
- □ The Name of The Current Manvantara = Vaivaswata
- \Box The Sequence of the Current Manvantara = 7^{th} Out of 14

OUR RELATIVE POSITION IN HISTORY

- □ We are in the 51st Brahma Year of 100 Brahma Years.
- □ We are in the 1st Brahma Day of the 51st Brahma Year, which is called the Varaha Kalpa.
- □ We are in the 7th Manvantara of Varah Kalpa
- \square We are in the 28^{th} Maha Yuga Out of 71 of 7^{th} Manvantara.
- □ This Would Place Us @ Approx. 456th Maha Yuga of the 1000 Maha Yugas (Kalpa) That Comprise a Day of Brahma.
- □ Within this Maha Yuga, we are in Kali Yuga. The 5100th Year of Kali Yuga corresponds to the year 2,000 A.D. That means that we are fairly early in Kali Yuga (~426,000 Years To Go).
